**1. Built environment with ramps/lifts or easy access to classrooms**

For disabled students, ramp is arranged by college for their convenience. During university examinations and other competitive exams special facilities are provided to disabled students. Also, if any students are unable to go to first floor due to any medical reason, we provide special facility to them accordingly.

**2. Disabled- friendly washrooms**

We take classes for disabled students near washrooms.

**3. Assistive technology and facilities for persons with disabilities (*Divyangjan*) accessible website, screen-reading software, mechanized equipment.**

Assistive facility for clear visualization of teaching matter by using LCD projector and placing them on front bench is used for visually impaired candidates.

**5. Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading**

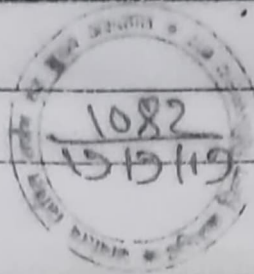
Our college students help disabled students during various examinations.

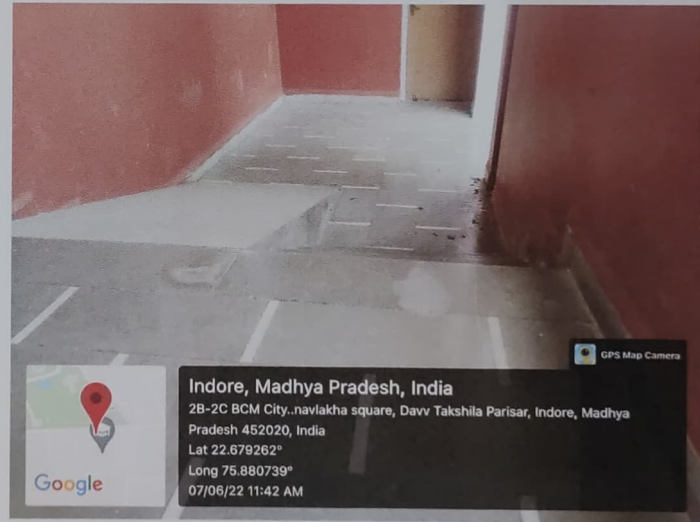

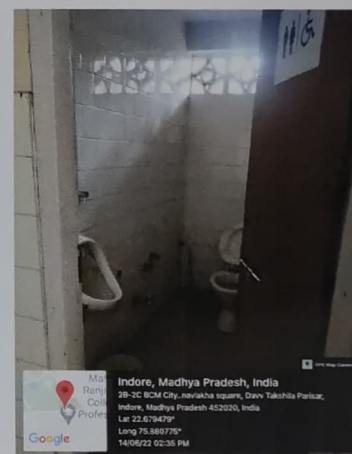
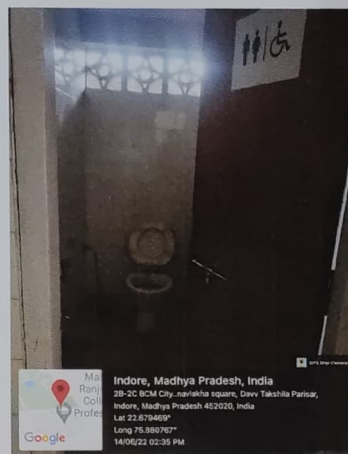
